Optimising Patient Care and Enhancing Patient and Family Orientation



- From ED to ICU, new patient admissions typically take 1 to 2 hours to complete.
- Delays include registered nurses (RN) being overwhelmed by critically ill patients.
- Long waiting time results in next-of-kins (NOKs) experiencing anxiety
- Admission documentation is often incomplete, resulting in gaps in patient records and potential lapses in care.


Empower, Guide and Share



Empower Enrolled Nurses (ENs) in proper patient / NOK orientation



Train ENs in effective communication skills and documentation proficiency



Encourage ENs to assist RN in completing the admission documentation in order to meet the 4-hr time frame stipulated by admission policy







Give NOKs and patients proper orientation on the admission process for a smooth and safe experience



Communicate the initiative's benefits to RNs, patients and NOKs during roll call

- RNs' workload is better managed
- √ 100% completion of admission documentation (up from 15%)
- √ Increased satisfaction and reduced anxiety for patients' families
