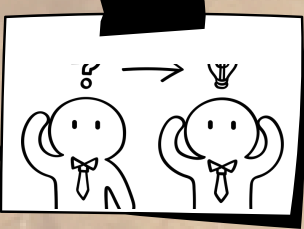

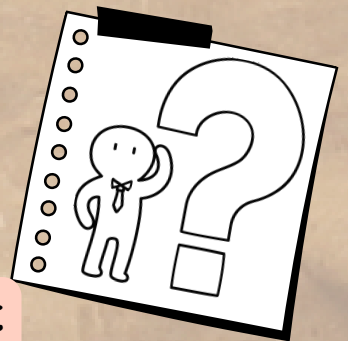

## CHALLENGES

- Wiring on medical carts (med carts) and Computers on Wheels (COWs) are messy and disorganised.
- Ward staff spend significant time disentangling wires before equipment can be used, impacting efficiency.
- Disorganised wiring poses a safety hazard, with reported incidents of staff tripping and falling.
- Exposed inner wires are visible due to wear and tear, increasing the risk of electrical hazard or equipment failure.



## IMPLEMENTATIONS



Gather honest staff feedback, and consolidate issues and concerns

Reach out to other subject matter experts (ORC), for assistance and guidance

Review the issues and challenges holistically, by reviewing all equipment

**Overcome challenges to create a safe and hazard-free environment**

Learn and re-learn, by finding efficient ways to housekeep the cables

Standardise clearing up of common workspace and housekeeping

Support from superiors

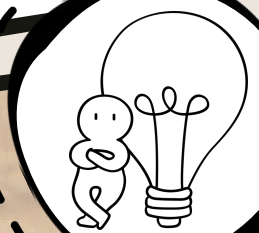
Medication cart
