Relocation of Urea Breath Test (UBT) from Endoscopy Centre (EC) to SOC

What is Stupid? Why is it Stupid?

- Patient has to report to various locations for **UBT** appointment and doctor's appointment.
- Endoscopy is located in restricted area. special requiring entry access.
- UBT noninvasive and nonendoscopic test that can be performed at Specialist Clinics Outpatient which is (SOC), more convenient for patients.

What was Implemented?

From 1 April 2024, UBT Service was relocated to SOC A32.

Before

- Patient registers at **Tower B, Level 2, AO**.
- Porter escorts patient to **Tower B, Level 3, EC** for UBT.
- After UBT, patient proceeds to Level 3 Discharge Lounge to obtain gantry exit pass.
- Patient goes to **Tower A, SOC** for registration of Doctor's appointment.

- Patient can proceed to Tower A, SOC A32 for UBT test and Doctor's consultation.
- unnecessary registration Reduced workload at multiple locations.

Impact

- At least 50% of patients can have the UBT test and doctor consultation in the same clinic.
- Time saved : \geq 25 mins of travel and waiting time at various areas.
- Reduced unnecessary use of at least **50 porter** tasks monthly.
- Improved patient satisfaction and experience as patient can access both test, results and consultation at one location.

Relocation of Urea Breath Test (UBT) from Endoscopy Centre (EC) to SOC

By relocating UBT Service to SOC A32, patients can now proceed to SOC A32 for registration of both UBT and Doctor's consultation. This reduces unnecessary registration workload at multiple locations

- Time saved : ≥ 25 mins of travel and waiting time at various areas
- Reduced unnecessary use of 50 porter tasks monthly.
